




WV VOTER REGISTRATION

- 2020 General Election Information from the WV Office of the Secretary of State
 - > 1,269,219 Registered Voters
- US Census WV 18+ Population Estimate for 2020 is 1,427,550
- High Percentage of Eligible Voter Population Registered for 2020 General Election - 88.9%
- Compared to **84.7%** in 2012


- Assessment of the WV Voter Registration Database as of 12/17/2021
 - Maximum Voter Registrations in a Day is 4,796 on 10/1/1998
 - ➤ Maximum Voters Registered in a Year is 77,770 during 2016




- Spikes in Voter Registration Start in 1990 and Continue
- Spikes in Voter Registration Occur in April and October of Each Election Year
- Spikes in Voter Registration are Significantly Higher in Presidential Election Years
- The Daily New Voter Registrations Steadily Increase Starting in 1995
- Even though the Spikes in Voter Registration for the 2012 2016 Presidential Election Cycle are Significantly Higher than The Spikes for the 2016 - 2020 Presidential Election Cycle, Over 32,500 More Voters were Registered in the 2016 - 2020 Cycle Meaning the Daily Voter Registrations Accounted for Much of the Significant Increase in New Voter Registrations
- The Pace of Daily New Voter Registrations from the 2016 2020 Presidential Election Cycle Continues into 2021





- Maximum New Voters Registered in a 4 Year Presidential Election Cycle
 - > 196,499 Between 2016 2020
 - > 163,954 Between 2012 2016
- Maximum New Voters Registered in a 4 Year Presidential Election Cycle Occurred While the WV Voting Age Population was Decreasing
- The Increase in Registrations between the 2016 and 2018 Elections (92,594) Represents Almost Twice the Number Registered between the 2012 and 2014 Elections (49,345), and Almost Two and a Half Times the Number Registered between the 2008 and 2010 Elections (37,129).






- Compared the Number of New Voter Registrants per Decade by the Age at Registration
- A Trend of Increased Voter Registration occurs in the 1990's and Continues
- A Trend of **Two Spikes** in New Registrants Starts in the 2000's and Continues
- The Spikes occur in the "20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, and 75" Ages for New Voter Registrations
- Why is the Spike Occurring?







- 196,499 New Voters were Registered between 2016 2020
- The New Voter Registration Rate from 2016 2020 is Approximately 49,100 per Year
- The WV Secretary of State's Office and County Clerks Cancelled 110,000 Registered Voters in 2021
- The 110,000 Canceled Registered Voters is on Pace to be Replaced by New Registered Voters in October 2023, While the WV Voting Age Population Shrinks Annually

- Online and Mail-In Voter Registration Process Invites Fraud
 - ➤ A System that is Setup to Accommodate Voter Registration of Members of Our Military, Citizens Living Abroad, Citizens Working in Other States, and Our Elderly can Easily be Used to Register WV Citizens Fraudulently
 - Access to Citizens Personal Data that is being Provided to ERIC (Voter Registration Database and DMV Database) makes Fraudulently Filling Out the Online or Mail-In Voter Registration Application Easy
 - ➤ The Application Allows for a Separate Mailing Address which the Voter Registration Notification and Voter ID Card are Sent
 - 238,808 Registered Voters have a Mailing Address that is Different from the Registration Address

West Virginia Voter Registration Application

Please read the instructions below. Note: Your registration cannot be processed without your full legal name, date of birth, driver's license or state ID number (unless none), residence address, affirmation of eligibility, and signature. Please print in blue or black ink.

- Line 1 Mark if this is a new registration, party change, or name/address change.
- Line 2 Provide your full legal name, including any suffix (such as Jr., Sr., III), date of birth, and gender. You must be at least 17 years of age and 18 by the next general election to register to vote.
- Line 3 Enter your DMV issued driver's license or state ID number. If you do not have a driver's license or state ID, enter the last four numbers of your social security number. If you do not have any of these numbers, enter the word "NONE," and a voter ID number will be assigned to you.
- Line 4 Provide your residence address (the address where you live). Check the box if you live within city limits. Include the name of the county where you live.
- Line 5 Provide the address where you receive mail, if different than your residence address. Enter a telephone number (for office use only) and email (for office use only).
- Line 6 Select your party choice. You may vote a party primary ballot only if you are registered with that party; however, parties may allow voters who are not affiliated with their party to vote their ballot upon request.
- Line 7 Enter the address where you were last registered to vote and the name under which you were registered.
- Line 8 Mark if you would like to be contacted about serving as a poll worker.
- Line 9 Carefully read each statement. If the statements are true, check the boxes, sign, and date. Knowingly providing false information is perjury, punishable on conviction by confinement in a penitentiary for not less than one nor more than ten years.

Voter Registration Deadline: This registration application will be in effect for the next election if mailed or delivered to your county clerk at least 21 days before the next election. For county clerk contact information, go to www.wvsos.gov.

First Time Voters: If you are registering to vote for the first time in W.V., or for the first time in this county, and you have not cast a vote in a federal election in this state, you must submit a copy of a current and valid ID with this application or show it the first time you vote. To submit with this form, include:


1) a copy of a current and valid photo ID, or 2) a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows your name and current residence address.

Overseas Citizens and Uniformed Service Voters: Overseas citizens who no longer reside in the United States may enter the last address at which they legally resided. Uniformed service voters should check with the Federal Voting Assistance Program for current instructions at www.fvap.gov.



- The Voter ID Number Assigned to New Registrants changed from a 7 Digit Number to a 9 Digit Number in 2004
 - > 77,695 New Registrants were Assigned Voter ID's between 2 to 7 Digit Numbers that were Registered from 2004 to 2021
 - Graphed the Number of New Registered Voters with Less Than 9 Digit Voter ID Numbers by Daily Registrations from 2004 to 2021



- The Voter ID Number Assigned to New Registrants changed from a 7 Digit Number to a 9 Digit Number in 2004
 - ➤ Graphed the Number of New Voter Registrations with Voter ID's Less Than 9 Digit Numbers from 2016 to 2021 by Their Age at Registration
 - The Spikes in the "35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70 and 75" Ages for New Voter Registrations Shows Up Again



- Voters Registered with Inaccurate Date of Birth Oldest Registrant 222 Years Old, 14 Registrants Older than 110 Years of Age
- 87 Voters Registered with Inaccurate Registration Date Including 1/1/1800, 1/1/1900, and Registration Dates that are Before or the Same as Their Date of Birth
- These Numbers, While Small, should be **Zero**. The Fact that the System Allows for these Errors Indicates a Disturbing Lack of Data Entry Integrity in the System.

5. How is ERIC Funded?

New members pay a one-time membership fee of \$25,000, which is earmarked to help cover expenses for technology upgrades and expansions necessary to support a growing membership. States also pay annual dues. Annual dues cover operating costs and are based, in part, on the citizen voting age population in each state. Thus, large states pay more in annual dues than small states. Members approve the dues and the annual budget. Dues for the 2021-2022 fiscal year range from about \$15,000 to about \$74,000. ERIC's 2021-22 operating budget is about \$1,037,000. ERIC conducts annual independent audits of its financial statements.

- Voter Registration Daily Data from 1990 to 2021 Indicates Abnormally Large Spikes In Voter Registration Before the May Primary and November General Elections with a Steady Increase in the Daily Registrations
- WV New Registered Voters Significantly Increased Between 2012 and 2020 which Does Not Follow the Significant Decrease In Voting Age Population
- Looking at the New Voter Registrants Age Versus the Decade They Registered In Shows a **Big Increase** in Voter Registrations Across Most Age Groups Starting in the 2000's. A Trend of Those with Ages of "20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, and 75" having a **Spike** in Registrations that Starts in the 2000's. The **Spikes** are **Not** a **Naturally Occurring Phenomenon**.

- WV Voter ID Numbers are Not Assigned in a Consistent Manner with Obvious Changes in the Number of Digits from 7 to 9 in 2004, Yet 2 to 7 Digit Numbers are Still being Issued Today. When Looking at the Age Groups being Assigned the 2 to 7 Digit Numbers, the "40, 50, 60, & 70" and "35, 45, 55, 65, & 75" Age Spike in Registrations Appears Again. The Spikes are Not a Naturally Occurring Phenomenon.
- The WV Secretary of State's Office Needs to Lead a Scrub of the Voter Registration Database to Clean Up Issues Such as Inaccurate Birth Dates, Inaccurate Registration Dates, Inaccurate Registration Addresses, Phantom Voters, Multiple Voters Registered at One Address, Multiple Voters Registered at One Invalid Address, and Double Voters Registered at One Valid Address
- The High Registration Rates for Most Age Groups are an Indication of Potentially Fraudulent Registrations are Occurring in Those Age Groups

- While Reviewing Valid Addresses with Multiple Registrants, Homeless Shelters, YMCA and YWCA, Substance Abuse Clinics, Nursing Homes, Assisted Living Homes, and College Dorms Represent the Majority of These Locations. The WV Election Code Allows for the Registration of Homeless (WV Code § 3-2-5(c)(3)(B) and § 3-2-16(b)(1)). The Registrants in this Category are Transient, Creating a Large Block of Registered Voters that can Easily be Used to Submit Fraudulent Votes.
- The Rate at which New Voters are being Registered is Out Pacing the Rate at which Voters are being Cancelled, While WV's Voting Age Population is Decreasing. It is too Easy to Fraudulently Register New Voters.

- Involvement in ERIC Supplies Critical Voting Age Population Data to a Third Party Company with Ties to Progressives
- The Data could be Used to Target a Certain Type of Person for Registration
- The Data could be Shared with Political Groups who Use Artificial Intelligence Software to Target Registered Voter's Cell Phones and Social Media Accounts to Influence Them to Vote or Not Vote
- Artificial Intelligence Software can also Monitor Social Media Accounts to Predict if a Registered Voter is Going to Vote

(Similar to How AI is used to Target US with Ads)










WV 2020 GENERAL ELECTION ISSUES

- Draza Smith is a Cyber Engineer with Two Masters Degrees, One in Electrical Engineering and One in Cyber Engineer. She Completed her Doctoral Work in Cyber Engineering and awaits her PhD Dissertation. She Worked for Sandia National Labs Focusing on Cyber and Grid Security.
- Investigated the 2020 General Election Data available through the New York Times (Edison Research and The Associated Press)
- Her Conclusion is that Results in Many States may Potentially have been Manipulated or Controlled via a Computer Algorithm
- The Computer Algorithm has been Programmed to Achieve a Specific Percentage of Votes at Each Location, Adjusting the Votes Up or Down during the Count to Reach the Target
- She Identified Cases where the Percentage of Vote Targets were Adjusted During the Ballot Counting Process after Certain States were Called (Florida)



- WV Election Code § 3-2-6 Time of Registration Application Before an Election
 - (a) Voter registration before an election closes on the twenty-first day before the election or on the first day thereafter which is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.
- For 2020 General Election, the 21st Day Before 11/3/2020 was **10/13/2020**
- In the 2020 General Election, 114 Voters Registered Between 10/14/2020 and 10/31/2020 and Voted in the Election

- 8,973 90+ Year Old Registered Voters
 - > 204 are Registered at Bad Addresses (General Delivery, Street Name Only, PO Boxes)
- 5,619 90+ Year Old Voted in 2020 General Election (Oldest Voter was 109 Years Old)
- 62.6% Voter Turnout in the 90+ Year Old Category
- 370 85 100 Year Old Registered to Vote for the First Time in 2020 and Voted in the General Election

WV 2020 GENERAL ELECTION CONCLUSIONS

- The Voter Turnout Does Not Appear to Be High at 63.25%, But Remove 110,000 Registered Voters Cancelled from the Voter Registration Database in 2021 and the Turnout Percentage becomes 69.25% which is Considered High
- The First Bullet Explains Why Certain Groups are Trying to Get as Many People Registered to Vote as Possible Using Legal or Illegal Means
- Absentee and Early Voting Methods Accounted for 51% of the Votes Cast in 2020, Each Age Group from 18 to 90 Years of Age Requested 1,000+ Absentee Ballots, The Level of Fraud is Significantly Higher in Absentee and Early Voting Methods
- Having a Large Percentage of the Votes Cast by Absentee and Early Voting Methods makes Injecting the Right Number of Votes into the Election Day Totals to Control the Outcome much Easier! The Election Counting Process does not have to Stop in the Middle of the Night and Last for Days to Reach the Desired Outcome.

WV 2020 GENERAL ELECTION CONCLUSIONS

- A High Level of Voter Turnout in Certain Age Categories in the 2020 Election is an Indication that Fraudulent Votes are being Cast in those Age Groups (Voter Turnout Percentages include the 110,000 Canceled Registered Voters which Artificially Reduce the Percentage)
- The Percentage of Challenged Ballots is an Indication that the Process to Challenge a Ballot is Not being Followed
- Voters Registering to Vote After The Date of Close of Registration for an Election Indicates that a Loop Hole in the Voter Verification Process Exists and Needs to Closed
- Double Registered/Double Voting at Same Address, and High Percentages of Elderly Registering and Voting is a Sign that The Procedure to Clean the Voter Registration Database needs to be Reviewed and Revised



- WV Code Concerns
 - Change Registration Code to Require Photo ID and Proof of Address During Voter Registration Process (Similar to Federal ID Requirements). If Online or Mail-In Voter Registration Application is Received, Code needs to Require that a Digital Face to Face Meeting Occur Between County Clerk Officials and Applicant for Further Verification of the ID of the Registrant.
 - Digital Voting Machines and Tabulation of the Votes is Not Secure. A WV Code Needs to Be Created that Requires **Paper Ballots** and **Hand Tabulations Only**. Digital Counting can be Used to Verify a Hand Count, But It should be Completed with Optical Scanners without Communications Capabilities and Flash Drive Ports.

- Allowing A Longer Period of Time to Vote Invites More Fraud.

 Tighten the Requirements for Receiving an Absentee Ballot, and Eliminate the Early Voting Period.
- Create a Code to Allow for a **Voter Feedback Loop** Consisting of an **Online Tool** to Allow Voters to Login and **See How** their **Votes** were **Counted**. Create **Online Process** to **File Complaint** about how Ballot was Counted.
- Create a Code that Requires ALL Election Data be made Public Information within 10 Days of the Certification of the Election. The Data will not Identify the Voter.

- Create a Code Against Sharing Voter Registration and DMV Databases with Third Party Companies such As ERIC. Require that the State of WV Maintain a Department of Software Programmers and Database Developers to Perform Such Tasks.
- Current WV Code does Not Require a Voter ID in Order to Vote.

 Require a Voter ID in Order to Vote in ALL Elections. Secure Our

 Elections!

- ➤ Homeless and Other Transient Groups being Registered to Vote should be Accompanied by a Strong Annual Maintenance of the Active Voter Registration Records. Transient Groups can be Identified by Researching Addresses with a Large Number of Registrations (> 20).
- If a Citizen Group can Find Data which is Considered Inaccurate, in the Voter Registration Database, the Database Maintenance Requirements Need to be Strengthened in the WV Code

WV VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTION ISSUES AND SUGGESTED CHANGES

- Issue A High Percentage of WV's Voting Population is Registered to Vote (88.9% for 2020 Election) with 360,453 New Voter Registrants Since 2012 while the Voting Population Decreased by 44,932. It is Obvious that Outside Parties are Fraudulently Registering WV Citizens to Vote.
- Solution Outside Parties Fraudulently Registering WV Citizens
 - ➤ Withdraw from ERIC, Develop the Expertise to Replace Any of ERIC's Beneficial Tasks within the Secretary of State's Staff or Other State Department
 - ➤ Complete Verification of **Entire** Voter Registration Database
 - ➤ Create a Temporary Task Force to Review Audit Procedure of WV Voter Registration Database and Modify the Audit Process, Leverage Database Experts within the Software Industry
 - Compare the Number of Registered Voters Versus the Number of Voting Age Population per Age Group to Look for High Registration Percentages
 - Require Photo ID and Proof of Residency to Register to Vote (Similar to Federal ID Requirements)

- Issue The Voter Registration Process is Too Easy and Invites Fraud. Groups with ERIC's Data Could Easily Register WV Citizens Online or by Mail by Simply Using a Mail Address that is Different from the Registration Address.
- Solution Revise Voter Registration Process to Protect Citizens Right to Vote
 - ➤ Online Registrations should Require in Person Follow-Up at County Clerks Office or an Online Video Meeting with County Clerk Designated Employee
 - ➤ Mail In Registrations should Require in Person Follow-Up at County Clerks Office or an Online Video Meeting with County Clerk Designated Employee
 - ➤ Require County Clerks Designated Employee to Visit Homes, Assisted Living Homes, or Nursing Homes to Confirm Elderly Registrants
 - ➤ Increase Enforcement of Current Voter Registration Fraud Laws

- Issue Many Issues Such as Inaccurate DOB, Registration Date, Invalid Registration Addresses, Phantom Registrants, Multiple Voters at One Address, Double Registrants Exist in the Voter Registration Database
- Solution Secretary of State's Office needs to Revise the Voter Registration Database Maintenance Procedure to Find the Identified Issues and Correct Them.

- Issue The WV Code Allows Homeless and Other Transient Populations to Register to Vote with The Result being that Large Numbers of Registered Voters are at One Address
- Solution Secretary of State's Office needs to Develop a Procedure to Identify Addresses used by the Transient Registered Voters and Determine the Status of Each Voter Registered at those Addresses Annually

- Issue The Voter ID Numbers were Changed from a 7 Digit Number to a 9 Digit Number in 2004, however, 2 to 7 Digit Voter ID's Continue to be Used
- Solution Revise the Procedure for Assigning Voter ID Numbers, Train County Clerk Personnel on Revised Procedure, Audit New Voter ID Numbers for 6 Months, Continued Use of the 7 or Less Digit Voter ID's should Result in the Database Rules being Updated to Prevent the Use of 7 or Less Digit Voter ID Numbers

Voting Process & Election Code

- Issue Absentee and Early Voting Accounted for 51% of Votes Cast in the 2020 Election and Also are Known for a Higher Percentage of Fraud
- Solution Absentee and Early Voting Percentage Increase
 - ➤ Eliminate the Early Voting Period (Citizens will Glady Trade Convenience for Secure Elections)
 - > Review **Absentee Ballot** Request Process, Tighten Criteria for Eligibility, Stiffen Ballot Tracking Process
 - > The Goal is 90%+ of All Votes should be Cast on Election Day

Voting Process & Election Code

- Issue Vote Counting and Reporting Process Needs to Be Secure
- Solution Vote Counting and Reporting Process Security
 - ➤ Hand Count and Verify with Optical Scanners, Report Totals by Phone
 - ➤ No Group Allowed to have Real Time Access to Precinct Reporting or State Totals Until Polls are Closed
 - ➤ Certification Process to Include Review of Paper Trail and Documentation of How Tabulation Issues were Resolved from Precincts
 - Create Online Voter Feedback Tool to Allow Voters to Login and See How Their Votes were Counted using the Ballot Number or Other Secure Method, Create Online Process to File Complaint about how Ballot was Counted
 - ➤ Online Voter Tool Vote Counts will Match Certified Election Totals

Voting Process

- Issue Low Percentage of Challenged Ballots
- Solution Secretary of State's Office, County Clerks, and Poll Officials to Review the Challenged Ballot Procedure, Determine Why it is not being Used, Remove any Obstacles to Challenging a Ballot, and Provide Training to Poll Workers on When and How to Challenge a Ballot

Voting Process

- Issue A Loop Hole Exists that Allows Newly Registered Voters to Vote in an Election Even if They Registered After the Date of Close of Registration for that Election
- Solution Secretary of State's Office needs to find the Loop Hole that is Allowing the Newly Registered Voters to Vote Before the WV Code Allows Them to Vote and Fix the Problem Whether it is Procedure at the County Level or a Code Problem at the State Level

WV Election Code

- Issue Sharing Citizen's Digital Data
 - ➤ ERIC having Access to the WV Voter Registration and DMV Databases is an Invitation for Citizens with Certain Views to be Targeted for Voter Registration
 - FRIC can Combine WV Citizen's Data with Other Digital Data to be Analyzed by Artificial Intelligence Software for Voting Tendencies and Whether a Voter is Likely to Vote in an Upcoming Election, Both of which Invites Voter Fraud
- Solution Sharing Citizen's Digital Data
 - Create Code that Prohibits the Secretary of State or any other State
 Government Agency from Entering into Contracts with Companies that Require
 WV Citizens' Personal Data be Shared with the Company

- Issue Digital Voting Devices are Not Secure
- Solution Digital Voting Devices are Not Secure
 - ➤ Eliminate Digital Voting Machines
 - ➤ Replace with Paper Ballots
 - ✓ Exclusive Contract with Ballot Publisher(s)
 - ✓ Ballots to have a Watermark
 - ✓ Ballots to have a Long, Sequential, Encrypted Number (i.e. WV384175602fzqeyh0000001) with a Tear Off Ballot Number for the Voter to Retain
 - ✓ Review Other Industry Leading Paper Ballot Security Measures and Implement
 - ✓ Require a Voter Signature with Blue Ink Pen for Verification Purposes
 - > Hand Count Ballots
 - Confirm Ballot Totals with Optical Scanners Without Flash Drives and Communications Capability

WV Election Code

- Issue In Person Voter Fraud Occurs
- Solution Develop Code to Require Drivers License or Voter ID to Vote in ALL Elections, Provide Voting Location Staff with Database of Drivers License Photos and Voter ID Photos for Election Day Verification

(Photo ID's are Required in Numerous Situations at Many Places of Work and in Our Personal Lives, **Secure Our Elections**!)

WV Election Code

- Issue Citizens Need Better Access to Election Information
- Solution Create a Code that Requires All Election Data be made Public Information within 10 Days of the Certification of the Election. The Data will not Identify the Voter.
