



TRUMP AND BIDEN % BEFORE AND AFTER BALLOT MANIPULATION MAIL-IN BALLOTS ONLY






Trump received 1.5% less of the presidential vote in 2020 than he did in 2016. Biden received 6.8% more of the presidential vote in 2020 than Clinton did in 2016. This is, overall, a "swing" of 8.3% in favor of Biden (2020) over Clinton (2016) Factoring in other races, the overall "swing" was closer to 11% to Democrat candidates.





TRUMP AND BIDEN % BEFORE AND AFTER BALLOT MANIPULATION MAIL-IN BALLOTS ONLY




Mesa County Colorado Analysis of Mail-In Votes 5,427 ballots (all but 100 of initial ballots processed) left behind in the original database show an almost exact 50/50 ratio between Trump and Biden.







TRUMP AND BIDEN % BEFORE AND AFTER BALLOT MANIPULATION MAIL-IN BALLOTS ONLY




19,529 ballots which were secretly reprocessed now show a very small advantage for Trump (51.4% to 48.6%)




The remaining 54,840 mail-in ballots show a commanding lead for Trump, at 67.4% to 32.6 %




Added together, the three sets of ballots combine for a 62.3% - 37.7% lead for Trump, more than 5% lower than the ballots processed after the secret operation.

Assuming that the 5,427 ballots left behind are artificially created, this adds 2,715 extra votes to Biden (and also to Trump).

Assuming that the original votes of the 19,529 ballots which were reprocessed more closely matched the ballots which followed, this adds 3,119 votes to Biden.

15 of Colorado's 64 counties – including some of its post populous – had double digit vote percentage changes towards Democrats between 2016 and 2020.
